

VOTER RE-ENGAGEMENT BRIEF TALKING POINTS

Character

- Joe Biden grew up in a middle-class family, and is fighting Republican attacks on our rights and our freedoms.
- Biden is protecting our rights to choose, to vote, and to love who you love.
- He's working to save our democracy.

Abortion

- President Biden is committed to protecting access to abortion so all women, in every state.
- He is fighting for women to be able to make their own health care decisions.

Economy

- President Biden is fighting for working Americans, not billionaires like Trump.
- Joe is taking on corporate greed to lower costs for everyone.
- He's created 15.7 million new jobs.
- By contrast, Trump wants to cut Social Security and Medicare while giving tax handouts to billionaires, take away the health care of 135 million Americans, and raise costs on working families.

Taxes

- Joe Biden believes that no billionaire should pay a lower tax rate than a school teacher or a firefighter.
- He's fighting to give tax cuts to the middle class.
- Democrats want the ultra-wealthy and big corporations to pay their fair share.
- By contrast, Donald Trump believes the tax code should work for billionaires rather than you and me. He's promising another Billionaire Tax Break that gives billionaires and corporations trillions of tax breaks, while making it easier for wealthy tax cheats to avoid paying taxes.

Social Security and Medicare

- Joe Biden is protecting Social Security and Medicare.
- Trump tried to cut Social Security and Medicare.
- Biden capped the cost of insulin at \$35 for seniors, lowered prescription drug prices, and is protecting your retirement savings from high fees.

Rebuilding America

- President Biden has invested in all our communities, passing the largest investment in infrastructure, rebuilding bridges and airports.
- He has created good-paying jobs and is bringing high-speed internet to all Americans.

Support for Veterans

- As a military father, President Biden believes we have an obligation to care for our service members and their families.
- Donald Trump called soldiers “suckers” and “losers”.

- Trump was the first president to try to overturn a free and fair election when he called on his followers to attack the U.S. Capitol on January 6. This terrible day in our history led to the deaths of five police officers.
